The Role

The overall purpose of the role is to guide and support the CPNY in the conduct of its business to deliver the best possible outcomes, as defined by the CPNY strategy, for the benefit of community pharmacy contractors.

The successful individual will provide exceptional leadership support to the Committee ensuring our organisation is at the forefront of the pharmaceutical environment in the areas we work in, via objectives:
