The University of Manchester and Health Education England would like to invite you to a half day professional advisory workshop on pharmacy learner experiences. The event is open to a wide range of pharmacy stakeholders, including pharmacists and pharmacy technicians involved in providing education and training in the workplace and learners who have undertaken education or training themselves. Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians from a variety of workplace sectors including community and hospital pharmacy, secure environments, primary care, GP practices or care homes are encouraged to attend.

The aim of the event is to **share research findings** gathered from pharmacists and pharmacy technicians across England who have recently completed an online education and training survey. Newly qualified participants have given their views on the training they received and more experienced participants have told us what they think about the education and training they have undertaken in the last year. We will also be discussing how well-prepared pharmacists and pharmacy technicians feel to take on expanded roles in the future, with the training they have received to date. We would like to hear your perspectives on our findings and give you an opportunity to **contribute to recommendations** to inform future Health Education England policy.
