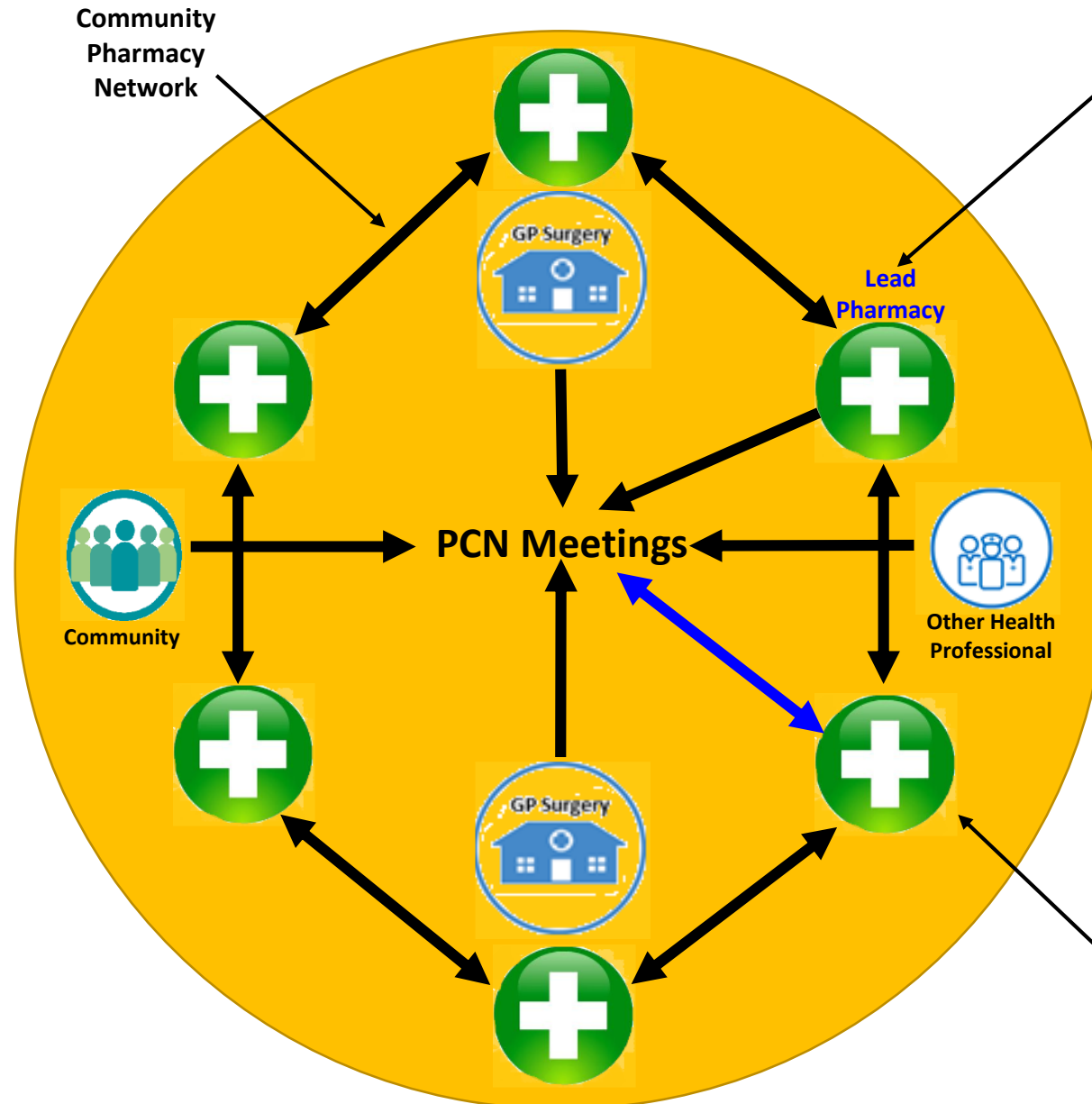
# Timeline For Establishing PCNs

By 15 May 2019	All primary care networks submit registration information to their CCG
By 31 May 2019	CCGs confirm network coverage and approve variation to GMS, PMS and APMS contracts
Early June 2019	NHSE/NHSI and GPC England jointly work with CCGs and LMCs to resolve any issues
1 Jul 2019	Network Contract goes live across 100% of the country
Jul 2019-Mar 2020	National entitlements under the 2019/20 Network Contract start: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Year 1 of the workforce funding</li><li>• Ongoing support funding for the Clinical Director</li><li>• Ongoing £1.50/head from CCG allocations</li></ul>

# Reasons Why You Should Engage With PCNs

Your Survival As Community Pharmacies Depends On It, Because Of The Interdependence Relationship Between PCNs And Community Pharmacies.

You will have greater control and influence over local medicine optimisation decisions

The Potential To Take On A Greater Paid Role Of Managing Patient's Condition Locally

Population Level Data Feeding In To PCNs Will Allow Pharmacies To Target Provision Of Both Locally Commissioned And Non-NHS Services To The Needs Of Their Communities.

If We Are Not Part Of PCNs, Then The System Will Likely Bypass Us and Opportunities To Better Use Our Skills Will Be Lost

# GPhC Premises Inspection (90 Minute Evening Workshops

Every registered pharmacy premises is required to have a responsible pharmacist appointed during the pharmacy's business hours. The responsible pharmacist is responsible for the safe and effective running of the registered pharmacy.

Why should pharmacies prepare for inspection?

- The new outcomes-based Inspections, which are being introduced, may be unannounced.
- Therefore all evidence and documentation needs to be immediately available for review at any time.
