# Flu Vaccination Practical Training and Basic Life Support

Training provided by ECG with ratio of 1 trainer per 10 people and covers:-

- IM and SC injection technique
- Adult basic life support
- Anaphylaxis and use of adrenaline.

**Online training will be provided which must be completed before the event. This training covers:-**

Pharmacists providing the flu service need to attend face to face practical training for both vaccination technique and basic life support every 3 years.

Once you have completed the online and practical course you will need to read and understand PGDs, SPCs, complete Declaration of Competence and if you are new to vaccination, undertake a period of supervised practice before undertaking vaccinations for the 2019/20 flu season.
