Our Awards ceremony is being held to recognise the excellent contribution to patient care, public health and community involvement that community pharmacies in North Yorkshire provide.

We will be presenting awards across 8 categories, giving the opportunity for pharmacies and individuals to be recognised.

The Awards will be presented at a celebration dinner by a celebrity host (to be announced).

Following the Awards ceremony and a three course dinner, the evening will also include a free raffle and disco into the night...

## Who is eligible?

All NHS community pharmacies in the area of CPNY are eligible to enter (or be entered) into the Awards. If you do wish to nominate an individual or another pharmacy please obtain their permission first!

### How do we enter?

Read the summary of categories below and then submit your nomination form to <u>laura.smart@cpny.co.uk</u> by the deadline. Applications should contain no more than 100 words per answer but you can attach other resources such as photos/posters as appropriate.

## When do we need to apply by?

The deadline for entries is Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

### What do we win?

Award winners will receive the recognition, a unique trophy and certificate to proudly display. All attendees will also be entered into a free raffle with some super prizes up for grabs!

### How much does it cost?

Entry is free and the Awards evening is also free to attend for shortlisted nominees. If there are places remaining for the event after shortlisted nominees have confirmed attendance, these will be released on a first come, first served basis free of charge.

## Pharmacy Team of the Year Award

A pharmacy's biggest asset is its staff – its pharmacy team. A good pharmacy team is greater than the sum of its parts, with every member using their individual skills to contribute to the group's overall objective – great patient care! Tell us why you are nominating this pharmacy? You may wish to consider the following: What impact has the team had on its patients? What impact has the team had on the pharmacy? How has the team improved the pharmacy's links with other healthcare professionals? Do you have a good news story to share about the pharmacy? Has the pharmacy gone the extra mile to help or assist patients? Has the pharmacy gone above or beyond its call of duty? What has the pharmacy done to deserve this award? Who benefited from this pharmacy's actions?

## Unsung Hero/Outstanding Person Award

A special award to recognise an individual who has gone the extra mile to make a difference for their team, patients or their community. Tell us why you are nominating this individual? You may wish to consider the following: Do you have a good news story to share? Has your nominee gone the extra mile to help or assist a patient or the community? Has your nominee gone the extra mile to help or assist the pharmacy team? Has your nominee gone above or beyond the call of duty? What has the individual done to deserve this award? What was the outcome? Who benefited from the individual's actions?

## Pharmacist of the Year Award

A great community pharmacist has many strings to his or her bow. Whether they are a branch manager, run their own pharmacy, or act as superintendent, they strive to be the best. They are a leader in their field, combining the day-to-day running of the pharmacy or pharmacies with cutting edge practice, be it clinical, business or management. An all-rounder who doesn't compromise one aspect of the job for another, they should be able to show how they have engaged the whole pharmacy team to help their patients. Tell us why you are nominating this individual? You may wish to consider the following: Have they maximised delivery of the community pharmacy contract, developed clinical services and built links with patients and peers? What impact have they had on their patients? What impact have they had on their pharmacy/pharmacies? How have they developed, utilised and motivated their pharmacy team(s)? How have they improved their own and their pharmacy/ies links with other healthcare professionals? What has the individual done to deserve this award? What was the outcome? Who benefited from the individual's actions?

## HLP Champion of the Year Award

A special award to recognise an individual who has thoroughly embraced the HLP Champion Ethos. A person who understands the basic principles of health and wellbeing, and that every interaction is an opportunity for a health promoting intervention? Tell us why you are nominating this individual? You



may wish to consider the following: Do they excel in making every contact count? Are they always open and friendly with patients, welcoming and sensitive to their individual needs? Do they embrace training to further develop and improve their engagement with patients and the community? Do they actively take part in promotion of campaigns, either in the community or within the pharmacy creating engaging displays in the health and wellbeing area? What has the individual done to deserve this award? Who benefited from the individual's actions?

## Trainee Pharmacist of the Year Award

Awarded to a trainee pharmacist who has demonstrated a significant contribution to the overall running of the pharmacy and achieved success from an innovative approach to professional services and patient care and promoting health and wellness. What has the individual done to deserve this award? What was the outcome? Who benefited from the individual's actions?

## Technology Award

For a pharmacy that has embraced new technologies, big or small and implemented them into their business to improve patient services, safety and/or to enhance business performance. What has the pharmacy done to deserve this award? What was the outcome? Who benefited from this pharmacy's actions?

## Local Healthcare Initiative of the Year Award

An award to recognise a pharmacy that has developed and introduced a local health initiative which has led to better health outcomes in their local community and demonstrated collaborative working between pharmacy and other healthcare professionals. What has the pharmacy done to deserve this award? What was the outcome? Who benefited from this pharmacy's actions?

## Community Pharmacy Heroes of the Year Award

All pharmacies have gone above and beyond during the Covid pandemic to ensure that patients have had access to everything they need. This is a very special award to recognise the pharmacy who can demonstrate supporting their local community in exceptional and/or unexpected ways in a time of crisis. What has the pharmacy done to deserve this award? What was the outcome? Who benefited from this pharmacy's actions?
